

## **Year 4 – Spring 2 Newsletter**



As we approach Easter at the Academy at St James, we will be focusing on our core value of Forgiveness. We are keen to promote the need to apologise, when we know we have not made the right choice. During this second part of the topic, we will be learning about how to protect foxes. We will explore foxes' natural habitats, the threats that they may face and how we can make a difference to help them. This will link to a Science focus of teeth and digestion.

## English and Reading

To continue with our topic, we are going to write and perform a poem about the dangers foxes face and their characteristics. Using 'Fox Tale' by Michael Foreman as our inspiration, we are going to write our own fox-based narrative. Following the success of our persuasive letters to help orangutan conservation, we are aiming to write to the government to ensure the safety of foxes in our country.

In Reading sessions, we are also going to focus on foxes and their relationship with humans, as we finish reading 'Pax' by Sara Pennypacker.

## Maths

We are going to learn about place value, more specifically with decimal (tenths and hundredths). This will include understanding of what digits mean, ordering decimals and converting between common decimals and fractions.

Year 4 will take the national times table test later this year. We strongly encourage your children to practise their tables at home. Every child has a Times Table Rockstars account that they can access at home.



## Topic and Science

In Science, we are going to be analysing the different teeth that humans have, and their function. Equally important, we will discuss how to look after our teeth, Subsequently we will research different animals' teeth, and compare the differences. From there, we will learn about food chains, diet and the digestion system. There will be an overall focus on maintaining our health.
