Brain workouts	Say cheese!
Complete the fractions homework you have been given. Remember to look at the examples to help you!	Research teeth to prepare for our learning in Science. What types of teeth do we have? How do we keep them healthy? Do animals have different teeth? Create a leaflet or report!
Play hangman, create word pyramids and think of tricks to help you learn your spellings.	Make a model of a set of teeth, or create a labelled scientific diagram.
Rockstars and Foxstars	Get Outside
Research the fox species – which animal group do they belong to? Which features do foxes have and how do they help them? Which habitats do they live in in the UK and the rest of the world?	Explore your local surroundings to find different natural habitats. Sketch and label the habitats. Which animals live there, and why is it a good home for them?
Create a mini sculpture or portrait of a fox or its habitat.	Visit a zoo, wildlife park or animal charity to discover what is being done to help save endangered and neglected animals.
