


Homework Menu for Year 1 and 2 – Autumn 1

<p style="text-align: center;">Spelling</p> <p>Bubble writing – write your spellings out in bubble writing.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Spelling</p> <p>Use an old newspaper or magazine. Find and cut up the letters that make up your spelling. Glue them into your homework book.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spelling</p> <p>Write a rhyming word for each of your spelling words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spelling</p> <p>Write your spelling words forwards and then backwards!
