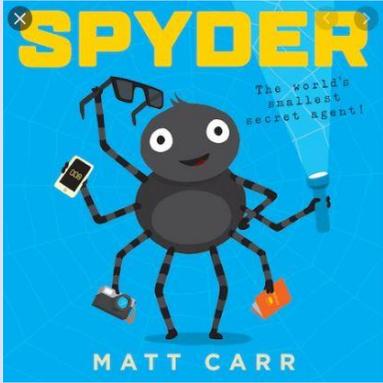

Silly Soup


You will need:

Sing the first part of the song to the tune of 'Pop Goes the Weasel': "I'm making lots of silly soup, I'm making soup that's silly. I'm going to cook it in the fridge, To make it nice and chilly! In goes... a ...

Challenge


Draw your favourite part of the story so far. Don't forget to say a sentence about your picture and write your name on.

Number challenge

Using number cards to 10 (from pack or write on paper). Encourage your child to place the numbers in the correct order.

Once they are in order begin by asking your child to point to a specific number. If they can go straight, too it without counting up then you know they really know them.

Once your child is confident at recognising numbers and placing them in order ask them to close their eyes and remove a number. Can they tell you which number is missing?

You will need:


- A soft toy to hide


