Cover with a blanket and remove one object. Can your child name the object that you have taken away?</p> <p>If your child is confident with 3 objects add another object.</p>

<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Tuesday</p>	<p><u>Socks and shakers</u></p> <p>Partially fill either opaque plastic bottles or the toes of socks with noisy materials (e.g. rice, peas, pebbles, marbles, shells, coins). Ask the children to shake the bottles or socks and identify what is inside from the sound the items make. From the feel and the sound of the noisy materials, encourage the children to talk about them. Encourage your child to hunt around your house/garden to find at least 2 of each.
