Monday	Can you draw an autumn picture and write you name on it? You could even label some of the things you have drawn.	Count how many things you can do in 30 seconds e.g. how many jumps can you do? How many times can you clap your hands?
Tuesday	Can you write the words to match the pictures? Use your phonic knowledge to help when writing your sounds.	Write your numbers 1 – 10 and cut them up into number cards. Muddle them up and see if you can order them correctly.
Wednesday	Make a card for one of your friends at school. Draw them a picture, write their name and your name.	Using the number cards from yesterday lay them out in a line. Close your eyes and get your grown up to turn 1 card over. Can you work out which one it is? Repeat with different numbers.
Thursday	Read a book with your grown up. Can you talk about what happened in the story? Can you name the characters?	Go on a number hunt around the house and garden. Which numbers can you find? You could take pictures. Can you find number 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10?
Friday	Use your phonics knowledge to help your grown up write a shopping list.	Write numbers 1 – 5 on pieces of paper. Can you find the correct amount of objects for each piece. You could look in the garden and use natural objects such as leaves or twigs.
