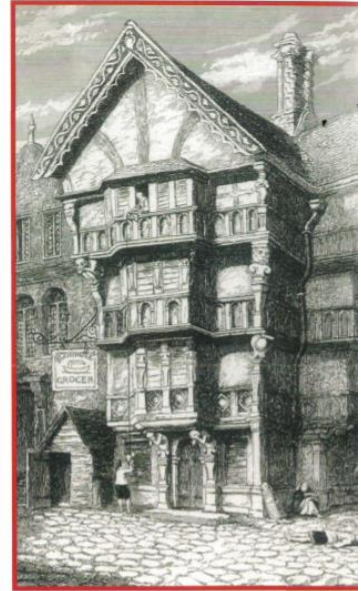
What was London like in 1666?
