Cogs Data Analysis

- 89% of young people said that they were more equipped to make themselves happy and had the tools and strategies to improve their wellbeing.
- 100% of young people felt they had the skills to make them more independent learners with good learning behaviours, making them better equipped for effective learning in the future.
- 100% of young people said that they felt more confident in themselves than at the start of the project. 78% of these scored themselves within the top scores in the self-assessment activity.
- 89% of pupils believed that they now put more effort into their school work, resulting in better outcomes. Their class teachers have agreed with this too.
- 100% of young people felt that they had better social and communication skills. 1 child scored themselves 1/10 at the beginning of the project and now score themselves 10/10.
 Their class teacher has also reported that this child is more confident when communicating in whole class and small group activities and this is helping his attainment in school improve.
- 100% of The Venturists felt more motivated and aspired in their school work and in helping
 in their community. They said that they wanted to do well in school so that they could have
 good career choices.

When asked to think about their key strengths at the end of the project the young people described themselves as supportive, confident, organised, a better thinker, helpful, loving and creative. They talked about these strengths with much more confidence and could give examples when they had demonstrated these skills; they genuinely believed in themselves.

Summative Assessments.

When looking at the skills progression in PSCHE and Citizenship The Venturists achieved the following by the end of the project. Exceeded demonstrates an above average understanding in these areas.

- Language & Communication 78% of young people achieved Exceeded. Showing above
 expected levels of communication, listening and responding to the ideas and opinions of
 others and they can communicate their thoughts in a variety of ways.
- Our Community 78% of young people achieved Exceeded. This thread included their understanding and application in resolving issues and bringing about change in their community.
- Relationships and Personal attributes 56% of the young people achieved Exceeded, demonstrating outstanding abilities to work in a team and show compassion and understanding towards other people's beliefs and opinions.
- **Enterprise** 78% of the young people showed an expected level of understanding in developing their own projects, budgeting and evaluating their final outcomes. 18% exceeded age related expectations.
